Civil Protection Test Alarm

all over Austria

on Saturday, 1st October 2011, between 12:00 a.m. and 01:00 p.m.

Austria has a nationwide warning and alerting system. It is possible to warn or alert the population in case of emergency with more than 8.193 sirens.

To familiarize you with the civil protection signals and at the same time to test the operability of the warning and alert system once a year

a civil Protection Test Alarm is carried out all over Austria,

operated jointly by the Federal Alarm Centre at the Federal Ministry of the Interior and the offices of the governments of the Federal Provinces.

Meaning of the signals

15 Sekunden

Testing of operability of sirens

15 seconds steady continuous tone

3 minutes steady continuous tone.
